Exodus 12:1-10

¹ Now the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying,

² “**This month shall be your beginning of months;** it shall be the **first month of the year to you.**”

³ Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: ‘On the tenth of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of *his* father, a lamb for a household.’



⁴ And if the household is too small for the lamb, let him and his neighbor next to his house take *it* according to the number of the persons; according to each man's need you shall make your count for the lamb.

⁵ Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year. You may take *it* from the sheep or from the goats.

⁶ Now you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month. Then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it at twilight.

⁷ And they shall take *some* of the blood and put *it* on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it.



⁸ Then they shall eat the flesh on that night; roasted in fire, with unleavened bread *and* with bitter *herbs* they shall eat it.

⁹ Do not eat it raw, nor boiled at all with water, but roasted in fire—its head with its legs and its entrails.

¹⁰ You shall let none of it remain until morning, and what remains of it until morning you shall burn with fire.

¹¹ And thus you shall eat it: *with* a belt on your waist, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. So you shall eat it in haste. It *is* the LORD's Passover.



1. Divine Intervention

- It's a new beginning – Month of Passover
- Be aligned with God's Prophetic Timing
- Abraham met Melchizedek of King of Salem, the Priest of God Most High
- Not my own calendar – God's intervention
- God shaking everything that can be shaken – Idolatry (Ex 12:12)
- Reset, Realign, Refire, Resurrection, Revival

2. Eat The Lamb with Unleavened Bread

Exodus 12:11

¹¹ And thus you shall eat it: *with* a **belt on your waist (Truth)**, your **sandals on your feet (Shoes of the Gospel)**, and your **staff in your hand (Sword of the Spirit)**. So you shall eat it in **haste**. It is the LORD's Passover.

- Unleavened Bread for Seven Days (Ex 13:7)
- A state of readiness – No time to play in Egypt.
- Red Sea? Stay in a place of faith (Hebrews 11:29)



Exodus 13:7

⁷ **Unleavened bread** shall be eaten **seven days**.
And **no leavened** bread shall be **seen** among you,
nor shall leaven be seen **among you** in all your
quarters.

Matthew 16:6

⁶ Then Jesus said to them, “Take heed and beware
of the leaven of the Pharisees and the Sadducees.”



Mark 8:15

¹⁵ Then He charged them, saying, “Take heed, beware of the **leaven of the Pharisees** and the **leaven of Herod.**”

Luke 12:1

In the meantime, when an innumerable multitude of people had gathered together, so that they trampled one another, He began to say to His disciples first *of all*, “**Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.**”

- Praise, Thank and Confess the Blood and the Name of Jesus
- Jesus is the Door
- Protection in Christ and His Church
- Walk in the Light (1 John 1:5-7)
- Take Holy Communion



Hebrews 10:19-23

¹⁹ Therefore, brethren, having **boldness** to enter **the Holiest** by the **blood of Jesus**,

²⁰ by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh,

²¹ and *having* a High Priest over the house of God,

²² let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

²³ Let us **hold fast** the **confession** of *our hope* without wavering, for He who promised *is faithful*.



1 John 1:5-7

⁵ This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.

⁶ If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.

⁷ But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

³⁶ He also destroyed all the firstborn in their land,
The first of all their strength.

³⁷ He also brought them out with silver and gold,

4. Midnight Hour

At midnight

- A great cry over death – Death of firstborn in Egypt (Exodus 11:5-7)
- Samson possessed the gates of the enemy (Judges 16:3)
- There was a cry made, “Behold the Bridegroom comes” (Matthew 25:6)
- Paul & Silas prayed and worshipped – Prison doors open (Acts 16:25-26)
- Paul preached to disciples until midnight
