Isaiah 40 – prior chapters

Isaiah 38

- King Hezekiah is told his time is up
- He pleads God and is given extra 15 yrs

Isaiah 39

- Hezekiah recovers from sickness
- Babylon's envoys visits
- Hezekiah shows them everything
- Isaiah prophesy of Babylonian captivity
- "at least there is peace in my time"

Focus is only on three aspects in this chapter



Isaiah 38:5-8

- ⁵ Then Isaiah said to Hezekiah, "Hear the word of the LORD of hosts:
- 6 'Behold, the days are coming when all that is in your house, and what your fathers have accumulated until this day, shall be carried to Babylon; nothing shall be left,' says the LORD.
- ⁷ 'And they shall take away some of your sons who will descend from you, whom you will beget; and they shall be eunuchs in the palace of the king of Babylon.' "
- ⁸ So Hezekiah said to Isaiah, "The word of the LORD which you have spoken is good!" For he said, "At least there will be peace and truth in my days."



Isaiah 40:1

¹ In those days Hezekiah was sick and near death. And Isaiah the prophet, the son of Amoz, went to him and said to him, "Thus says the LORD: 'Set your house in order, for you shall die and not live.'

#1: Be Strengthened (Isa 40:1-2)



Isaiah 40:1-2

¹ Comfort, yes, comfort My people! Says your God. Speak comfortably to Jerusalem and cry out to her.

² God cares for His people and knows the difficulties we go through to. Comfort – this word can convey to us of consoling. We may have this picture of a mother soothing a baby who is crying.



Luke 22:31-32

³¹ And the Lord said, "Simon, Simon! Indeed, Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as wheat.

³² But I have prayed for you, that your faith should not fail; and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren."



#2: Shout (Isa 40:3 – 8)



Isaiah 40:3 - 4 (CEV)

³ Someone is shouting: "Clear a path in the desert! Make a straight road for the LORD our God.

⁴ Fill in the valleys; flatten every hill and mountain. Level the rough and rugged ground.





Luke 17:26-36

- ²⁶ And as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be also in the days of the Son of Man:
- ²⁷ They ate, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and the flood came and destroyed them all.
- ²⁸ Likewise as it was also in the days of Lot: They ate, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they built;





- ²⁹ but on the day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven and destroyed *them* all.
- ³⁰ Even so will it be in the day when the Son of Man is revealed.
- ³¹ "In that day, he who is on the housetop, and his goods *are* in the house, let him not come down to take them away. And likewise the one who is in the field, let him not turn back.



- ³² Remember Lot's wife.
- 33 Whoever seeks to save his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life will preserve it.
- ³⁴ I tell you, in that night there will be two *men* in one bed: the one will be taken and the other will be left.
- ³⁵ Two women will be grinding together: the one will be taken and the other left.
- ³⁶ Two men will be in the field: the one will be taken and the other left."



Isaiah 40:6-8

⁶ Someone told me to shout, and I asked, "What should I shout?" We humans are merely grass, and we last no longer than wild flowers. ⁷ At the LORD's command, flowers and grass disappear, and so do we. ⁸ Flowers and grass fade away, but what our God has said will never change.

²¹ Don't you know? Haven't you heard?

Isn't it clear that God created the world?
