Leviticus 23:1

¹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ² "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'The **feasts** of the LORD, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, these are My feasts.



Feast of Passover (1st month) Feast of Weeks/Pentecost (3rd month) Feast of Tabernacles (7th month)



The Feast are Inter-related

- The Word "Feast" here is literally "an appointed time"
- Sons of Issachar understood the times and knew what they ought to do
- The feasts are all fulfilled in Christ
- The Feasts are all inter-related and each point to the next
- We are progressing





Exodus 5:1

¹ Afterward Moses and Aaron went in and told Pharaoh, "Thus says the LORD God of Israel: 'Let My people go, that they may hold **a feast** to Me in the **wilderness**.' "

What feast is that?





Pentecost







1. Feast of Weeks (Number 50)

You had to count seven Sabbaths or seven weeks from the Day of the Sheaf of Firsfruits (During Passover)

1 week = 7 days

7 weeks = 7×7 = 49 days

The feast was on the day after the seventh sabbath

Number 50

 50 is the number of liberty, freedom and deliverance

• Year of Jubilee
Slaves were free, debts were cancelled, liberty was proclaimed throughout all the land, families were reunited...



2. Feast of Harvest

Harvest of Wheat

On the Day of Pentecost, about 3000 souls were

added to the LORD.



3. Feast of Firstfruits

- The choicest, the first, the best
- Sheaf of <u>Firstfruit</u> in <u>PASSOVER</u> speaks of the resurrection of Christ, the firstborn from the dead
- The <u>firstfruits</u> in <u>PENTECOST</u> speaks of the <u>early</u> converts
- Speaks of the more to come
- Speaks of a greater Harvest
- It leads us to the Harvest at the Feast of Tabernacles





1 Corinthians 15:20-21

²⁰ But now **Christ** is risen from the dead, and has become the **firstfruits** of those who have fallen **asleep**.

²¹ For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead.



Exodus 5:1

¹ Afterward Moses and Aaron went in and told Pharaoh, "Thus says the LORD God of Israel: 'Let My people go, that they may hold a feast to Me in the wilderness.'

What feast is that?





Exodus 19:1

¹ In the **third month** after the children of Israel had gone out of the land of Egypt, on the same day, they came *to* the **Wilderness of Sinai**.



4. Baptism of the Spirit & Fire

- Mt Sinai Law written on tablets of <u>stone</u> by the <u>finger of God</u>
- Mt Zion Law written on the tablets of our <u>heart</u> by the <u>Spirit of God</u>

Jesus is the Baptizer of the Holy Spirit & Fire



Exodus 31:18

18 And when He had made an end of speaking with him on Mount Sinai, He gave Moses two tablets of the Testimony, tablets of stone, written with the **finger of God**.



Luke 11:20

²⁰ But if I cast out demons with the <u>finger of God</u>, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you.

Matthew 12:28

²⁸ But if I cast out demons by the <u>Spirit of God</u>, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you.



2 Corinthians 3:3

³ clearly you are an epistle of Christ, ministered by us, written **not** with ink but by the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on **tablets** of flesh, that is, of the **heart**.



2 Chronicles 5:11-14

11 And it came to pass when the priests came out of the Most Holy Place (for all the priests who were present had sanctified themselves, without keeping to their divisions),

12 and the Levites who were the singers, all those of Asaph and Heman and Jeduthun, with their sons and their brethren, stood at the east end of the altar, clothed in white linen, having cymbals, stringed instruments and harps, and with them one hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets—



¹³ indeed it came to pass, when the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD, and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised the LORD, saying:

"For He is good, For His mercy endures forever,"

that the house, the house of the LORD, was filled with a cloud,

14 so that the priests could not continue ministering because of the cloud; for the glory of the LORD filled the house of God.



Exodus 19:10-11

¹⁰ Then the LORD said to Moses, "Go to the people and consecrate (Sanctify) them today and tomorrow, and let them wash their clothes.

- 11 And let them be **ready** for the third day. For on the third day the **Lord will come** down upon Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people.
- ¹⁶Then it came to pass on the third day,...
- ¹⁷ And Moses brought the people out of the camp to **meet** with God,



5. Consecrate (Sanctify) Yourself

From the **Hebrew word "Kadash**" which is the **root** word for "**HOLY**."

- To be clean (To Sanctify)
- To purify
- To be separated
- To be set apart
- To dedicate

We make ourselves ready to meet God (Ex 19:11, 17)



- Preparation of heart
- God is sanctifying a people unto Himself (Titus 2:14)





Luke 1:17

¹⁷ He will also go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah, 'to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,' and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord."



Psalm 24:3-4

³ Who may ascend into the hill of the LORD? Or who may stand in His holy place?

⁴ He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, Nor sworn deceitfully.
