# Hebrews 5:9-10

<sup>9</sup> And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him,

<sup>10</sup> called by God as **High Priest** “according to the order of **Melchizedek**,”

<sup>11</sup> of whom we have much to say, and hard to explain, since you have become dull of hearing.



<sup>12</sup> For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need *someone* to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food.

<sup>13</sup> For everyone who partakes *only* of milk *is* unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe.

<sup>14</sup> But solid food belongs to those who are of **full age**, *that is*, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.



# MELCHIZEDEK

- **Melchizedek means King of Righteousness**
- **Melchi = King**
- **Zedek = Righteousness**



# Priest After Order of Melchizedek

- A Kingdom of Priests and Righteousness
- **JESUS** is **THE KING-PRIEST**
- We are kings and priests under **JESUS** the King of Kings and the Great High Priest



# Exodus 19:6

<sup>5</sup> Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth *is* Mine.

<sup>6</sup> And you **shall be to Me a kingdom of priests** and a holy nation.’ These *are* the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel.”



# Matthew 6:31-33

- 31 “Therefore do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’
- 32 For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things.
- 33 But **seek first** the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

<sup>9</sup> And they sang a new song, saying:  
“You are worthy to take the scroll,  
And to open its seals;  
For You were slain,  
And have redeemed us to God by Your blood  
Out of every tribe and tongue and people and  
nation,

<sup>10</sup> And have made us **kings** and **priests** to our  
God;  
And we shall reign on the earth.”

# Ecclesiastes 3:11

<sup>11</sup> He has made everything beautiful in its time. Also He has put **eternity in their hearts**, except that no one can find out the work that God does from beginning to end.





## 2. Made To Receive Eternal Things

- God is from **Everlasting to Everlasting**
- These **Eternal things** are the things which are in the **mind of God, the mind of Christ.**
- They are the spiritual things revealed by the Holy Spirit



# Proverbs 25:2

<sup>2</sup> *It is the glory of God to conceal a matter,  
But the glory of kings is to search out a matter.*



# 1 Corinthians 2:9-16

<sup>9</sup> But as it is written:

“Eye has not seen, nor ear heard,  
Nor have entered into the heart of man  
The things which God has prepared for those who  
love Him.”

<sup>10</sup> But God has revealed *them* to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.



<sup>11</sup> For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God.

<sup>12</sup> Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.

<sup>13</sup> These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.



<sup>14</sup> But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know *them*, because they are spiritually discerned.

<sup>15</sup> But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is *rightly* judged by no one.

<sup>16</sup> For “who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him?” But we have the mind of Christ.



# Deuteronomy 29:29

29 “The **secret *things*** belong to the **LORD our God**, but those *things* which **are revealed** belong to **us** and to **our children** forever, that *we* may do all the words of this law.



# 2 Corinthians 4:18

<sup>18</sup> while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are **seen** *are* **temporary**, but the things which **are not seen** *are* **eternal**.



# Matthew 4:4

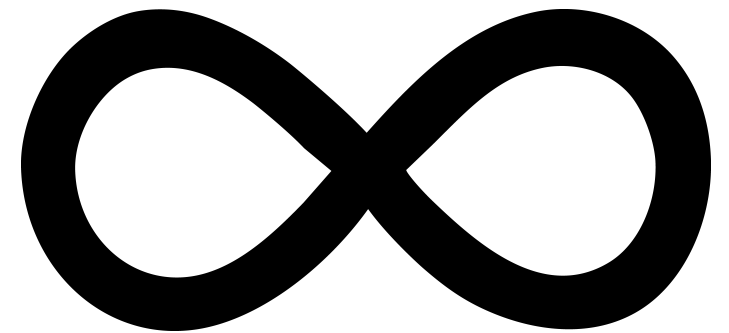
<sup>4</sup> But He answered and said, “It is written, ‘Man shall not live by **bread alone**, but by **every word** that proceeds from the mouth of God.’ ”





# 3. Seek Eternal Things

# Matthew 6:19-21

- <sup>19</sup> “Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal;
- <sup>20</sup> but lay up for yourselves **treasures in heaven**, where **neither moth nor rust destroys** and **where thieves do not break in and steal.**
- <sup>21</sup> For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

# Psalm 17:13-15 (AMP)

<sup>13</sup> Arise, O LORD, confront him, cast him down;  
Save my soul from the wicked with Your sword,

<sup>14</sup> From men with Your hand, O LORD,  
From men of the world [these moths of the night] whose  
portion [of enjoyment] is in this life—idle and vain,  
And whose belly You fill with Your treasure;  
They are satisfied with children,  
And they leave what they have left [of wealth] to their  
children.

<sup>15</sup> As for me, I shall see Your face in righteousness;  
I will be [fully] satisfied when I awake [to find myself]  
seeing Your likeness.
