# DEFINITION: Sanctify

- It is where God **sets apart** of something or someone for Himself **from all evil use**, to be wholly used **for Himself** and **His service**.
- The HEBREW ROOT Word for “HOLY” is “SANCTIFY”

<sup>11</sup> For the bodies of those animals, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are **burned outside the camp.**

<sup>12</sup> Therefore Jesus also, that He might **sanctify** the people with **His own blood**, suffered **outside the gate**.

<sup>13</sup> Therefore let us go forth to Him, **outside the camp**, bearing **His reproach**.

<sup>14</sup> For here we have no continuing city, but we seek the one to come.

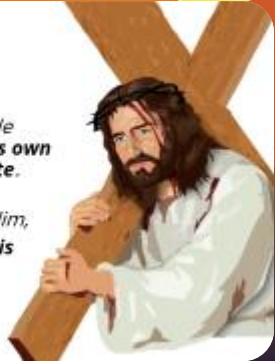

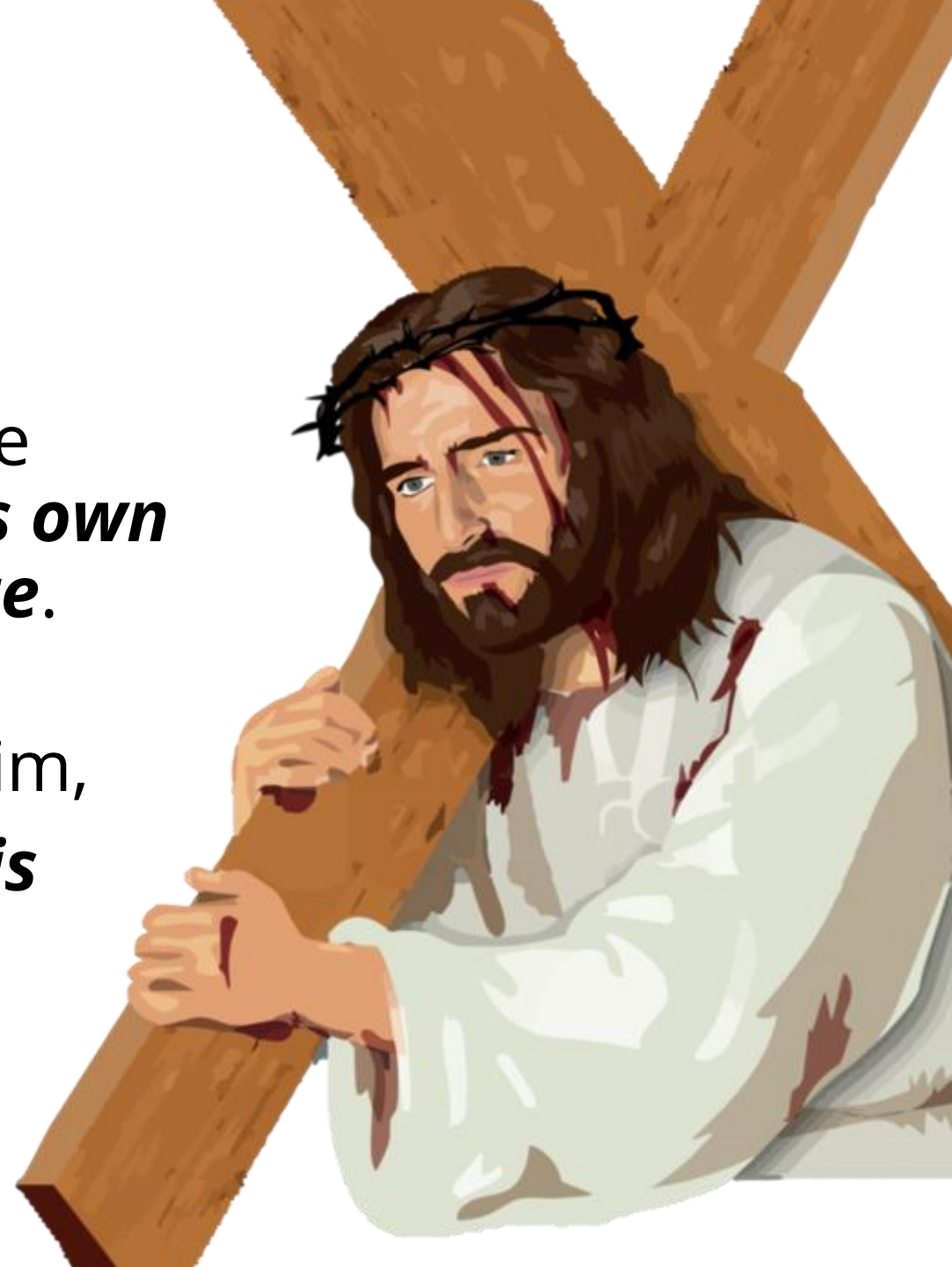

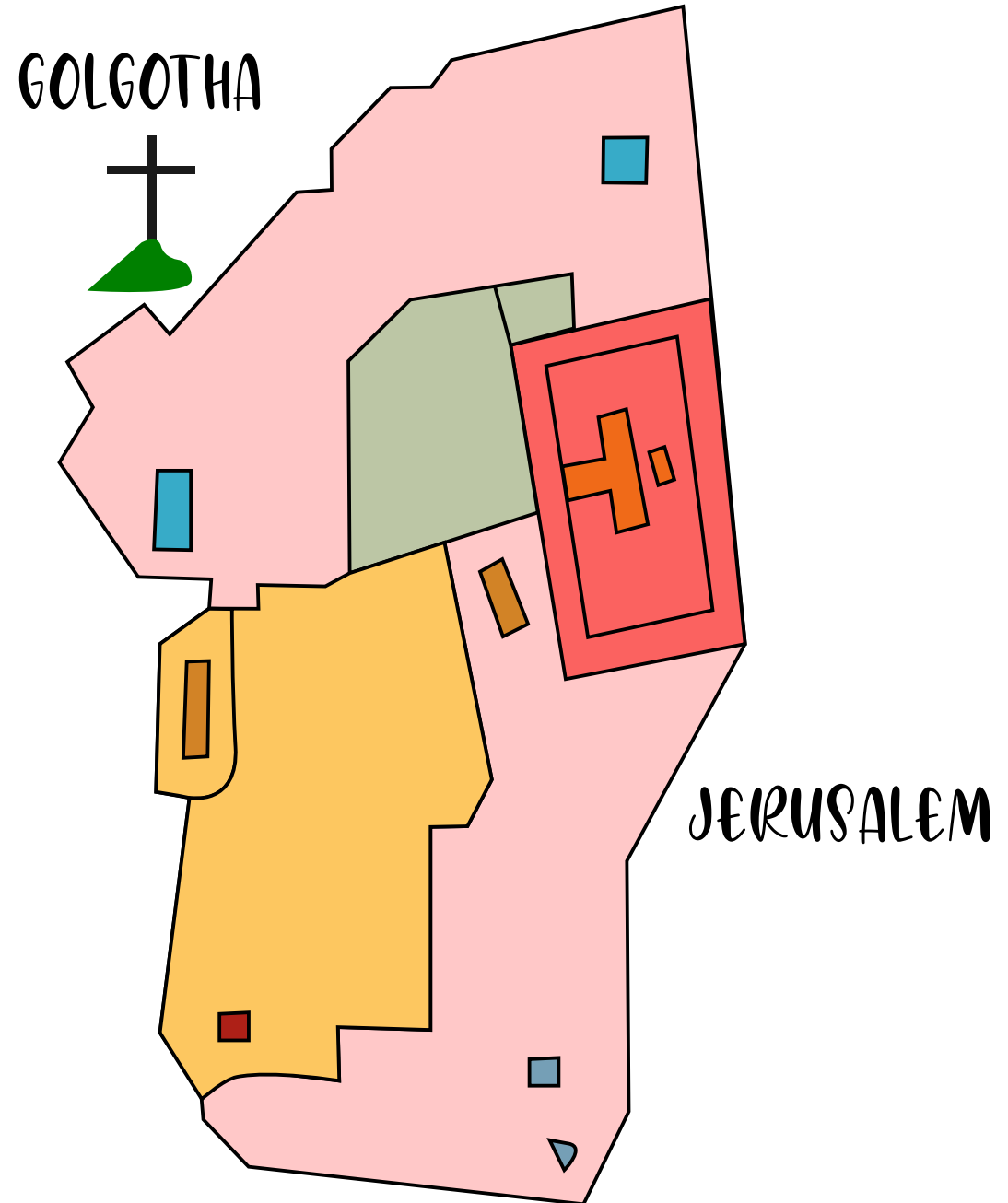

# Leviticus 4:12

<sup>12</sup> the **whole bull** he shall carry **outside the camp** to a **CLEAN PLACE**, where the ashes are poured out, and **burn it** on wood with fire; where the ashes are poured out it shall be burned.

## Matthew 26:36-39

<sup>36</sup> Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and said to the disciples, "Sit here while I go and pray over there."

<sup>37</sup> And He took with Him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and He began to be sorrowful and deeply distressed.

38 Then He said to them, "My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death. Stay here and watch with Me."

39 He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, "O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will."

# Leviticus 4:12 (KJV)

SIN OFFERING



<sup>11</sup> And the skin of the bullock, and all his flesh, with his **head**, and with his **legs**, and his **inwards**, and his **dung**,

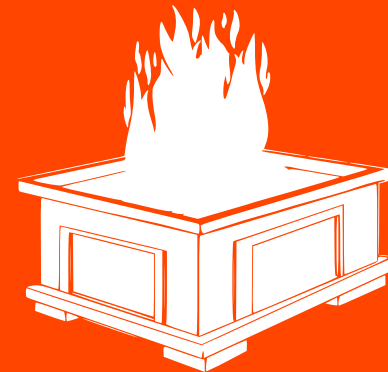
<sup>12</sup> Even the whole bullock shall he carry forth **without the camp** unto a **clean place**, where the ashes are poured out, and **burn him** on the wood with fire: where the ashes are poured out shall he be burnt.

# Leviticus 1:10-13

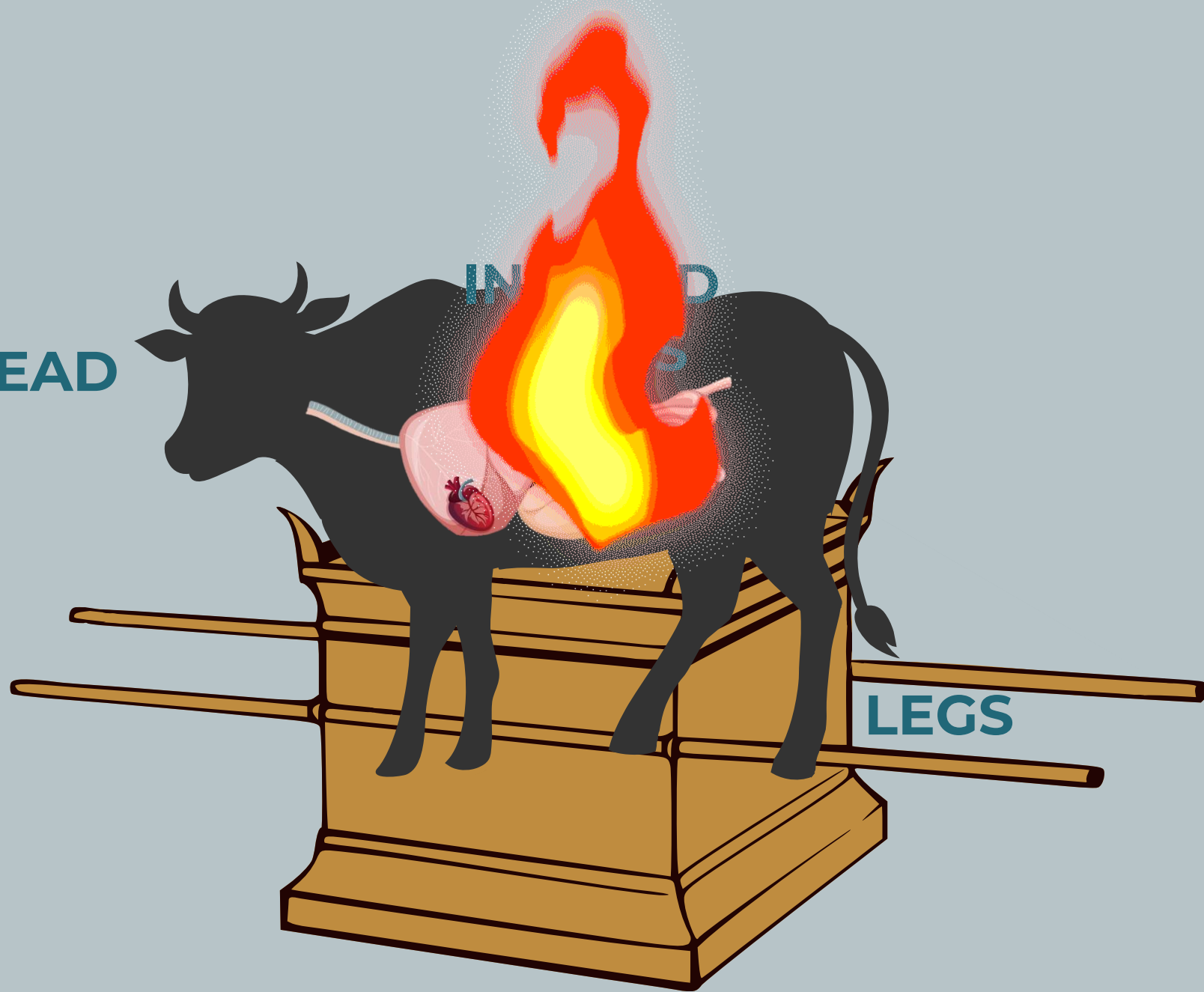
**10** 'If his offering is of the flocks—of the sheep or of the goats—as a burnt sacrifice, he shall bring a male without blemish.

**11** He shall kill it on the north side of the altar before the LORD; and the priests, Aaron's sons, shall sprinkle its blood all around on the altar.

<sup>12</sup> And he shall **cut it** into its pieces, with its **head** and its **fat**; and the priest shall lay them in order on the wood that is on the fire upon the altar;

<sup>13</sup> but he shall **wash** the **entrails** (inwards) and the **legs** with **water**. Then the priest shall bring it all and **burn** it on the **altar**; it is a **burnt sacrifice**, an offering made by fire, a sweet aroma to the LORD.

## Psalm 51:6

<sup>6</sup> Behold, You desire truth in the **inward parts**,  
And in the hidden part You will make me to know  
wisdom.

## Proverbs 20:27 (KJV)

<sup>27</sup> The spirit of man is the candle of the Lord, searching all the **inward parts** of the **belly**.



## Luke 11:39

<sup>39</sup> Then the Lord said to him, “Now you Pharisees make the outside of the cup and dish clean, but your **inward part** is **full** of **greed** and **wickedness**.”

# Romans 12:1

<sup>1</sup> I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your **bodies** a **living sacrifice**, **holy, acceptable** to God, which is your **reasonable service**.

## Romans 6:13

<sup>13</sup> And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but **present** yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your **members as instruments of righteousness** to God.
